The Personality of LUIS E. GUERRERO, M.D.

- Belonged to that rare breed of men in the last century who combined sound scholarship, broad culture, high professional ideals and unselfish patriotism
- Leader of scientific thought, famed clinician and moral practitioner
- Insisted on accuracy of diagnosis and simplicity of treatment, especially in drugs administered to the patient
- Had uncanny memory and accurately retained facts and data
- Consistently updated himself by reading the latest journals and books until the last months of his life
- Wrote several short stories in Spanish, published in the 1990's
- Probably the only Professor and Chairman simultaneously in two Colleges of Medicine: UP Medicine & UST Pediatrics
- Extremely laconic in conversation, never given to idle conversation; with patients and students, serious and cold; economical in words, apparently indifferent; with friends, would engage in lengthy discussions on politics, literature, religion, history
- In spite of a "dry behavior" towards his patients, his home and office were always filled with people
- Was a sportsman who loved deep-sea fishing and hunting
- Late in life, studied the Chinese language so he could understand his Chinese patients and obtain clinical data firsthand
