298th Dr. Luis Ma. Guerrero Memorial Lecture Virgilio D. Salanga, M.D., M.S.
UST Medicine Class 1967

Dr. Guerrero, who was the personification of sound relationship, professional idealism and unselfish patriotism, was a venerable product of an equally venerable institution - The University of Santo Tomas. He was the only physician of his time who simultaneously served as professor and chairman of two Colleges of Medicine. The Department of Pediatrics of the University of Santo Tomas and The Department of Medicine of the University of the Philippines. An eminent medical practitioner and illustrious professor, Dr. Guerrero also became the first Dean Emeritus of the UST Faculty of Medicine and Surgery. The first Memorial Lecture was given in 1951 and since then world renown authorities in medicine have traveled to the Philippines to give the lectures.
